The Farncombe Initiative is about improving the environment and building a sense of local community. The Farncombe Initiative is not alone in this. Other groups, including clubs, churches and various organisations, do this too. But The Farncombe Initiative is an unusual (perhaps unique) coming together of local councillors and residents to find ways to achieve this goal.

The Farncombe Initiative meets in the evening at a local venue about six times a year. Residents volunteer to take part in the group which is supported by local councillors and town council staff. Members may simply attend to offer ideas and take part in the discussion. Many are also happy to spend a small amount of time between meetings helping to turn ideas into reality.

The Farncombe Initiative was formed in 2013 and since then has arranged for a variety of improvements in the village. These include:

- Resurfacing pavements by the shops
- Placing of the "Farncombe Village" sign and rejuvenating the boarder beneath it
- Litter picks throughout Farncombe and Binscombe
- Installation of a new seat by the Marshall Road footbridge
- The introduction of Christmas lights to the village centre
- Planting of an ornamental tree
- Arranging for Godalming Trust to install a blue plaque commemorating local resident, Jack Phillips
- Bulb planting
- Fighting to keep Farncombe public toilets open

Further initiatives are currently underway:

- Improvements to the station and around the railway
- New planting at Green Lane shops
- Promoting Farncombe businesses
- Celebrating the Farncombe swifts
- Finding space for public art
