# **Blood Pressure Home Monitoring Scheme Guidelines For Patients**

Once you have agreed with your usual Doctor to monitor your blood pressure (BP) at home, we recommend you purchase a suitable blood pressure machine. If you wish you can bring your machine to an appointment with the practice nurse and she will demonstrate the correct procedure for taking and recording BP measurements. Wrist and finger BP machines are **not** recommended.

#### **Recommended BP machines.**

1. **Omron M3** Basic machine, easy to use but ONLY FITS WITH

STANDARD SIZE CUFF

2. Omron M6 or M7 Slightly more expensive & sophisticated, will work

with any sized cuff

3 Omron 705IT More expensive but can link to computer to allow

readings to be recorded in Excel

<u>Cuff Size:</u> Depends on the size of your upper arm but <u>must</u> be

correct for accurate readings.

Small adult	18-22cm (upper arm circumference)	= small cuff
Standard adult	23-32cm	= standard (Easy Cuff)
Large Adult	33-50 cm	= large cuff
